**All Wales Striking Competition and Association Social Day  
Saturday 30 September 2017**



The Association is delighted to be hosting the All Wales Striking Competition on Saturday 30th September in Abergavenny. This year's competition will be slightly different to those in previous years as we have tried to design a full programme that will involve some fun elements and be open to both those ringing in the competition and those not.

We are now in a position to give more details about what is planned for the day. More information will follow but we hope this will whet your appetite enough for you to reserve the date in your diary. You'll see from the programme below that we are planning a Treasure Hunt, a meal and a fun quiz as well as open ringing at two towers. Abergavenny is a lovely place to visit so we hope there will be something for everyone, both ringers and non-ringers. We are also offering the opportunity to ring some quarter peals in the morning. The programme for the day will be as follows:

Time	Location	Activity
Morning	Abergavenny area	Quarter peals involving ringers from the four Guilds/Associations, if demand.
1.00pm - 2.00pm	St Mary, Abergavenny (10, 25cwt)	Open ringing, distribution of Treasure Hunt clues and draw for the competitions.
2.15pm - 3.15pm	St Mary, Abergavenny	8-bell competition (Treasure hunt to take place whilst the competition is going on and continue at Pertholey.)
3.30pm - 4.30pm	St Teilo, Llantilio Pertholey (6, 12cwt)	6-bell competition followed by open ringing until 5pm.
5.15pm onwards	Llantilio Pertholey Community Hall, St David's Rd, Mardy, Abergavenny, NP7 6HF.	Judges Remarks and Results followed by a meal at 6pm and a table quiz.

We are currently in the process of confirming details of the evening meal and will provide a further update in due course.
