A Quarter Peal is a special bell-ringing performance, lasting about 45 minutes and starting and finishing with the bells striking "rounds," all the bells in order from the highest to the lowest

Ringing a quarter peal takes a lot of concentration

All the bells are rung more than 1250 times, each time the sequence in which they are rung is different from the last, for example;

12345

21354

23145

32415

32451

Etc.

If more than 7 bells are being used in the pattern each order of the bells should be different.

If less than 7 bells are being used in the pattern, sequences are repeated to make up the required length, no sequence is rung more than once more than any other.

Quarter peals are rung for many reasons; before services, to give ringers practice, to celebrate special occasions, in memory of people and just for fun.
